

Owl Finger Puppet

Supplies Needed:



Toilet paper roll



or



Craft paint, or markers



Construction paper

Scissors



Glue



Quarter



Start by painting or coloring your tube, or you can wrap it in construction paper and glue it on.

Fold the top of the toilet paper roll to create the ears, try to make the fold as sharp as possible by pinching it with your fingers.

For the feathers, use a quarter to trace circles on to the construction paper and then cut them out. Glue the top of the circles on to the tube starting at the bottom and working your way up to the top of the tube.

To make the eyes, cut out two white circles and two black circles (or use large googly eyes if you have them.) Glue the black circle on to the white circle and then glue it on to your tube.

Cut out one triangle shape for the beak and glue it on. Then cut out two ovals for the wings and then glue them on. Cut out one heart shape, turn it upside down and glue it to the bottom of the tube for the feet.

Look at the two examples below for inspiration. Be creative and use the materials that you have handy.
